CAREER OUTCOMES REPORT INTRODUCTION

This report contains detailed post-graduation career outcomes for the **NYU Stern Undergraduate College Class of 2024**, which consisted of 796 graduates whose degrees were conferred between August 2023 and May 2024. Data was collected up to six months after graduation through NYU's annual *Life Beyond the Square (LBTS)* survey, with additional input from other sources, including information shared online (e.g., LinkedIn) and direct phone and email communication with students. The total *knowledge rate* for the Class of 2024 was 85.1%, or 677 confirmed career outcomes. The following pages contain details on these outcomes, with a particular focus on those who chose to pursue full-time employment.



CLASS OF 2024 FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT RATE

In the Class of 2024, **95.4% of students** who sought full-time employment had obtained a full-time role within three months of graduation. The chart below shows historical full-time employment outcomes dating back to the Class of 2021.

CONTINUING EDUCATION

In the Class of 2024, **5.9% of students reported continuing education** (i.e., graduate school) as their primary post-graduation outcome. Outside of the Stern BS/MS in Accounting program, the most common disciplines were business (17), computer science (4), and law (2), and the most popular institutions were Columbia (7), NYU (4), Cornell (3), and the University of Chicago (3).

INTERNSHIP INSIGHTS

In the Class of 2024, **96.9% of students reported pursuing at least one business-related internship** prior to graduation. This includes summer internships and fall or spring semester-based internships, which are common for NYU Stern students given the school's proximity to businesses in New York City. The chart below shows historical internship data.



SALARY & COMPENSATION TRENDS

The average total compensation (base salary + signing bonus) for Class of 2024 graduates was **\$107,157.** Average compensation for Stern graduates has **increased 22.7% since 2021** and is typically more than **30% higher than the national average** for business majors, according to data from the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE).
